Mobile Hotspot Information

This program is designed to give North Union students learning from home, with the greatest need and no (or extremely limited) Internet access outside of school, the opportunity to receive a wireless hotspot.

- The mobile hotspots are available for check-out at the North Union District Office. Multiple students can sign-on to the same mobile hotspot, so families will be limited to one hotspot per household.
- The checkout term will be from when the device is assigned to a student until June 3, 2021 or if/when the student returns to at-school learning.
- If a student withdraws from North Union Local Schools, the device shall be returned immediately.
- The program is intended to help North Union students access necessary online resources to continue learning outside of the building walls.
- Devices are to be used for educational purposes only.
- Parents/Guardians assume all responsibility for equipment signed out to a student, and a replacement fee of \$60.00 will be charged if the device is lost, damaged or not returned.

Steps for Obtaining a Hotspot:

1. Complete the North Union Local Schools Mobile Hotspot Application and return it to the North Union District Office.
2. Application approval will be granted to students who meet the eligibility requirements on a first-come, first-served basis. Eligibility requirements are:
 - Student is enrolled in North Union Local Schools
 - Priority will be given to students participating in the free/reduced lunch program, but North Union Local Schools reserves the right to loan a device to any deemed in need.
 - Student's household has no or extremely limited Internet access
3. If application is approved, the student will be contacted by North Union district staff to receive the hotspot.
4. All hotspot loans are for the duration of the school year (due back on or before 6/3/21), or immediately upon withdrawal from the district, or if requested by the district.

How Much Will The Hotspot Cost?

- The hotspot and the monthly service fee for the device is paid by North Union Local Schools.
