OUR COMMUNITY

North Union Local Schools is a rural school district with approximately 1,480 students. North Union High School is located in the village of Richwood in northern Union County. The school district is equidistant from Delaware, Marion, and Marysville with good proximity to Columbus. Most sports compete in Division III of the OHSAA.

NORTH UNION HIGH SCHOOL

- North Union is a four-year high school with an enrollment of 470 students. The graduating class of 2021 had 115 students. Approximately 70 students per year attend Tri-Rivers Career Center in nearby Marion for career-technical training.
- The school is fully accredited by the Ohio Department of Education.
- North Union has 35 certified/licensed professional staff. Of these, 16 have earned their Masters Degrees.
- School is in session 180 days between the months of August and June each year.
- The school day begins at 7:40 a.m. and ends at 2:40 p.m.
- There are eight periods in the school day and a 30-minute lunch.
- Each period is 42 minutes in length.
- North Union Local Schools are rated “Excellent with Distinction” by the Ohio Department of Education.

SCHOLARS RECOGNITION

The Class of 2009 had 1 National Merit Finalist and 2 Commended Scholars. The class of 2017 had 1 National Merit Finalist.

ADMISSIONS STATEMENT

North Union High School is a member of The Ohio Association of College Admission Counseling and the high school follows the Statement of Principles and Good Practices as adopted by OACAC.

PROGRAMS OF STUDY

The curriculum at North Union High School is diverse and comprehensive, including: Honors (English only), Advanced Placement, College Prep, College Tech Prep, College Credit Plus, and Career-Technical courses. Students may also choose to attend Tri-Rivers Career Center in Marion for additional career-technical training. Dual-Credit programs with Marion Technical College are in place. An Early College Partnership has been formed with Marion Technical College. We offer career pathways in Agricultural Science, Construction, Interactive Media, Pre-Nursing, and Business.

Advanced Placement Course Offerings: The first opportunity to take an AP course is grade 10.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS AND GRADE REPORTING
